Individual Clinician Performance Information on Physician Compare Performance Year 2018 Preview Period

Overview

This document summarizes the individual clinician performance information, plain language measure and activity titles¹, and utilization data that will be available for preview in June 2020 and publicly reported on Physician Compare² later in the year. Physician Compare will publicly report clinician performance information from the 2018 Quality Payment Program. Performance information that meets statistical public reporting standards (valid, reliable, comparable, and meet the minimum reliability threshold) will be included in the Downloadable Database (§414.1395(b)).³ A subset of this information will be added to Physician Compare profile pages. Any information publicly reported on profile pages must also resonate with patients and caregivers, as shown through user testing. Per the Medicare and CHIP Reauthorization Act (MACRA), Physician Compare is required to publicly report eligible clinicians' final and performance category scores. Additionally, Physician Compare will publicly report a subset of 2017 clinician utilization data in the Downloadable Database.

Under §414.1395(d), the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) provides a 60-day Preview Period for eligible clinicians and groups to preview their 2018 Quality Payment Program performance information before the data are publicly reported on Physician Compare.

The Preview Period begins on June 22, 2020 at 10 a.m. ET (or 7 a.m. PT) and ends on August 20, 2020 at 8 p.m. ET (or 5 p.m. PT).
