### **COVID-19 Vaccine Codes: Updated Effective Date for Moderna**

On December 18, 2020, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration issued an <u>Emergency Use Authorization</u> (<u>EUA</u>) for the <u>Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine</u> for the prevention of COVID-19 for individuals 18 years of age and older. Review Moderna's <u>Fact Sheet for Healthcare Providers Administering Vaccine (Vaccination Providers)</u> regarding the limitations of authorized use.

During the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE), Medicare will cover and pay for the administration of the vaccine (when furnished consistent with the EUA). Review our updated <u>payment and HCPCS Level I CPT code structure</u> for specific COVID-19 vaccine information. Only bill for the vaccine administration codes when you submit claims to Medicare; don't include the vaccine product codes when the vaccines are free.
