**SUBJECT:** Special TRR for PDP Reassignments

**Notice for Prescription Drug Plans of the Special TRR for PDP Reassignments and Certain Auto/Facilitated Enrollments**

On Tuesday, October 14, 2008, CMS transmitted to certain PDPs the one-time files described in the HPMS memo, "Reassignment of LIS-Eligible PDP Members Effective January 1, 2009," dated August 29, 2008. These files provided a preliminary listing of LIS-eligible beneficiaries whom CMS will reassign to a new PDP effective January 1, 2009.

On or about Friday, November 14, 2008, CMS will transmit to certain Prescription Drug Plans (PDPs) a special MARx-generated Transaction Reply Report (TRR) containing the confirmed enrollments and disenrollments resulting from the reassign process. This special TRR will also include auto/facilitated enrollments that had been generated since November 1<sup>st</sup> but pended because they had January 1, 2009 effective dates.

The different types of transactions can be identified by the accompanying Transaction Reply Codes, as follows:

- **212 Re-Assignment Enrollment Accepted**
- **014 Disenrollment Due to Enrollment in Another Plan**  
Note: the general TRC code will be used to confirm disenrollments due to reassignment
- **117 FBD Auto Enrollment Accepted**
- **118 LIS Facilitated Enrollment Accepted**

As a reminder, **please do not submit 4Rx records for the beneficiaries contained in the one-time reassign files until after you receive the special MARx-generated Transaction Reply Report (TRR) on or about Friday, November 14, 2008, which**

**will contain the confirmed enrollments resulting from the reassign process.** This is because the October 14 preliminary list may not exactly match the list of beneficiaries who are ultimately enrolled in your plan since voluntary plan elections may occur after the preliminary file is created. Once the Special TRR is received, the normal timeframe for submitting 4Rx data applies (i.e. 3 business days).
