

ERRATA SHEET FOR MINIMUM DATA SET (MDS) VERSION 2.0 (1/30/98)

The following are areas of change on the 1/30/98 version of the MDS 2.0.

SECTION AA. IDENTIFICATION INFORMATION

ITEM AA8b. "Special codes for use with supplemental assessment types in Case Mix demonstration states or other states where required" has been revised to read:

b. Codes for assessments required for Medicare PPS or the State

- 1. Medicare 5 day assessment**
- 2. Medicare 30 day assessment**
- 3. Medicare 60 day assessment**
- 4. Medicare 90 day assessment**
- 5. Medicare readmission/return assessment**
- 6. Other state required assessment**
- 7. Medicare 14 day assessment**
- 8. Other Medicare required assessment**

NOTES:

1. Item definitions have not yet been developed. They will be posted on this web site as soon as they are available.
2. The "b" codes have been revised to include all types of assessments that will be required under the Medicare PPS system that will be implemented 7/1/98.
3. Codes under "a" apply to Federally required assessments, while codes under "b" apply to assessments required for Medicare PPS or the State. Codes "a" and "b" have been "decoupled," meaning that the assessor needs to place a code in "a" (which may be "none of above") regardless of whether a code is placed in "b."
4. The code for "Medicare 14 day assessment" appears out of order. It was added after codes 1-6 were in place, and was placed as number 7 to minimize reprogramming.

ITEM T1. Instruction in bold italics between items a and b has been revised to read:
Skip unless this is a Medicare 5 day or Medicare readmission/return assessment.

ITEM A4a: Previously read "Date of Readmission"

Has been revised to read: "Date of Reentry" and change instruction to: Date of reentry from most recent temporary discharge to a hospital in last 90 days (or since last assessment or admission if less than 90 days).
