HQRP COVID-19 Public Reporting Tip Sheet is Available

The <u>HQRP COVID-19 Public Reporting Tip Sheet (PDF)</u> is now available. The purpose of this Tip Sheet is to help providers understand CMS' public reporting strategy for the Post-Acute Care Quality Reporting Program (PAC QRP) in the midst of the COVID-19 public health emergency (PHE). This Tip Sheet explains the CMS strategy to account for CMS quality data that we exempted from public reporting due to COVID-19 PHE, and the impact on CMS' <u>Care Compare</u> website refreshes. Care Compare

Beginning in September 2020, CMS transitioned to <u>Care Compare</u> on Medicare.gov to publicly report HQRP quality measures relating to care provided by hospice programs across the country. Publicly reporting these data fulfills the HQRP mandate, as directed in section 1814(i)(5) of the Social Security Act. <u>Care Compare</u> is a streamlined redesign of the former Hospice Compare and seven other CMS compare tools. It provides a single user-friendly interface that patients and caregivers can use to make informed healthcare decisions based on cost, quality of care, volume of services, caregiver feedback, including the willingness to recommend a hospice, and other data. In addition, providers with data on <u>Care Compare</u> can start a conversation with their patients and family members about Care Compare by:

- Explaining that Care Compare provides a snapshot of the quality of care a hospice offers;
- Encouraging patients and their family members to review quality ratings; and
- Helping to strengthen patients and family members' ability to make the best decisions for their care.

<u>Care Compare</u> displays quality measures based on the Hospice Item Set (HIS) and CAHPS® Hospice Survey data. For the HQRP quality measures reported on Care Compare, visit the <u>Current Measures</u> page. <u>Care Compare</u> also posts data on the characteristics of Medicare hospice organizations from the Hospice Provider Utilization and Payment Public Use File (PUF), which has hospice data for 2014-2016, and the Post-Acute Care (PAC) PUF, which has data beginning with 2017. By providing these data in a user-friendly way on <u>Care Compare</u>, consumers can use this information, along with the HIS and CAHPS® Hospice Survey-based quality measures in selecting a hospice.

Note about Public Reporting for CY 2021

Due to the temporary exemption to the HQRP data submission requirements in responding to the COVID-19 PHE, public reporting of hospices' data will freeze after November 2020 refresh. This means that following the November 2020 refresh, the data publicly reported will be held constant through the November 2021 refresh. Further, no Provider Preview Reports will be issued for those refreshes that continue to display the constant or frozen data.
