## Medicare and Medicaid Notice to Public

Notice is hereby given that on August 27, 2022, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will terminate the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Hi-Line Retirement Center, located in Malta, MT, as a skilled nursing facility in the Medicare program. In addition, as authorized by the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services, notice is given that the provider's agreement as a nursing facility in the Medicaid program will also be terminated effective August 27, 2022. These actions are taken because CMS has determined that Hi-Line Retirement Center failed to attain substantial compliance with certain Medicare and Medicaid participation requirements. If the provider demonstrates substantial compliance with all CMS requirements, and a revisit survey confirms substantial compliance, prior to August 27, 2022, the provider will remain active in the Medicare Program, and CMS will not terminate their provider agreement.

In addition, Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after August 27, 2022. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to August 27, 2022, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to 30 days of covered services to qualified residents furnished on or after August 27, 2022, the date of termination.
