

Prior Authorization of Power Mobility Devices (PMDs) Demonstration

Background

CMS implemented a Prior Authorization process for scooters and power wheelchairs for people with Fee-For-Service Medicare who reside in seven states with high populations of fraud- and error-prone providers (CA, IL, MI, NY, NC, FL and TX). This demonstration was intended to help ensure that a beneficiary's medical condition warranted their medical equipment under existing coverage guidelines.

The Prior Authorization of Power Mobility Devices (PMDs) Demonstration ended as scheduled on August 31, 2018.
