**Italics indicate approximated numbers. Total Medicaid population was provided by the Office of the Actuary which used 2082 data to calculate average Medicaid enrollees over 1995. The managed care population differs from the 11,619,929 reported in the 1995 report as the number represented enrollment of some beneficiaries in more than one plan.*

The Total Medicaid Population for 1996 through 1999 was collected by States at the same time the managed care enrollment numbers were collected instead of using 2082 data as had been done in previous years.
