The Department of Community Health, PeachCare for Kids is submitting Amendment #10 to Georgia's State Plan for Title XXI.

Amendment #10 includes:

- In Section 3.1, the GBHC primary care case management fees are reduced from \$3 to \$2 per month.
- Sections 4.3 and 8.7 indicate a change in enrollment policy in which children will be ineligible for reinstatement for 3 months following a cancellation due to non-payment of premium.
- Sections 4.3 and 8.2 increase the monthly premiums for families with children over the age of 5, on a sliding scale based on family income.
- Section 8.5 describes how the State ensures that the revised premium structure, in aggregate annual cost sharing, does not exceed 5 percent of family income.
- Sections 4, 4.3 and 4.4 increase the crowd-out provision to require children to be uninsured for at least 6 months prior to enrollment in PeachCare for Kids.
- Section 9.9 expands the public notice process.
