You need to choose a CHIP managed care plan for your children!

To get medical care for your children, you must choose one of the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) managed care plans in your county. You can pick your own plan. If you don't, we will choose one for you.

The following steps will help you decide:

1. Look at the **2001 CHIP Plans by County** list with this letter to find out which plans are in your county.
2. Most people choose the plan their doctors are with. Ask your doctors which CHIP plan they are with.
3. If you don't have doctors you want your children to stay with, call the CHIP plans in your county. Ask questions about doctors and services that are important to you. Then choose one plan for your children.
4. Once you have chosen your CHIP plan:
 - Call the toll free number below to enroll by phone. Or,
 - Fill out and mail the enclosed enrollment form.
