Dear Commissioner Arnold:

On September 22, 2017, the Department of Health & Human Services and the Department of the Treasury approved Minnesota's State Innovation Waiver under Section 1332 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). Minnesota's approved application waives the ACA's requirement for the single risk pool to the extent necessary to implement a state reinsurance program called the Minnesota Premium Security Plan for plan years 2018 through 2022.

It is the Department of the Treasury's final administrative determination that Minnesota's pass-through funding amount for calendar year 2022 is \$91,110,030, which must be used for purposes of implementing Minnesota's State Innovation Waiver.
