The following are CMS policy and billing procedures regarding the circumstances under which a supplier may deliver durable medical equipment, prosthetics, and orthotics - but not supplies - to a beneficiary who is in an inpatient facility that does not qualify as the beneficiary's home.

NOTE: This pre-discharge delivery instruction does not apply to customized prosthetics that are excluded from Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNF) Consolidated Billing (CB). Customized prosthetics that are excluded from the SNF CB rule may be billed separately during the skilled nursing stay.
